 - a. Remember a title and abstract are an **advertisement** for a paper. Most people will read the title of a paper and a fairly large number will read the abstract, but if it doesn't sound interesting, people will stop reading.
 - b. Remember the title and abstract are a **summary** of the paper; highlight the key methods, results, and conclusions.
 - c. When possible, use "plain English", so a broad audience will understand what the paper is about.
